- **Format** (several items ongoing since April 2025):

  - Updates to Format Guides (from April 2025 MB):
  - Solo Drumming Circuit: updates to be actioned.
  - Bands: some clarity points required.
  - Drum Majors: Section 10 requires expansion. Request submitted to BoD for a working group (under SOR 2.19).
  - Liaison with SOR on dual instruments ongoing.
  - Local Rules: Branches reminded to send a copy of any local rules to HQ. The Format Group
    wishes to review for good practice and ensure alignment with National Rules. Branch
    Secretary is requested to forward any local rules if available.
- From April Branch Meeting Minimum Player Numbers:
