Playing requirements

Grade 2 MSR Grade 3/Juvenile Medley

Grade 4/Novice MSR MSR set from RSPBA list of prescribed tunes.

Grade 4 March A selection of Marches lasting 2 ½ to 4 ½ minutes duration. Novice March A selection of Marches lasting 2 ½ to 4 ½ minutes duration.

Note: Playing requirements may be altered to match the following Major Championship, but bands who have entered will be notified in advance.

- 1. The contest will be run under RSPBA rules.
- 2. Entries and payment to be made via Branch website www.rspba-landb.org/entries
- 3. Entry Fees: All Grades £10.00, Adult D/M's £5.00, Juvenile D/M's £Free
- 4. Bands may play one grade higher. If time permits.
- 5. Closing date for entries is 28th April 2023
- 6. Draw will take place electronically on 1st May 2023 and will be posted on the following websites: www.rspba.org and www.rspba-landb.org and the St Ronan's Piping Society Facebook Page. (Just search for St Ronan's Piping Society, like & share the page for more information and updates)
- 7. Late entries will be accepted and bands will be asked to play first.
- 8. Any band arriving by coach must indicate on the online entry where applicable for coach pass.
- 9. Bands may be asked to play for Drum Majors.
- 10. Bands are expected to take part in the March Past and Street Parade.
- 11. All winners of last year's trophies should ensure that they are returned by Wednesday 26th April 2023 to: M. Rendle, 27 Craig Terrace, Innerleithen, Peeblesshire, EH44 6LU. Tel: 01896 830013

Note: Failure to do so may result in a fine of £50 per trophy, and suspension from all RSPBA events until the trophy is returned and the fine paid.

- 13. All bands must register on arrival.
- 14. Bands failing to notify Lothian & Borders branch of the RSPBA that they will not be taking part in the contest will be liable to a fine set by the Board of Directors.

This will <u>NOT</u> count as 'playing-up'. <u>If you intend to play in both, please ensure you mention this on the entry form in the area provided for the tunes. The additional entry fee will need to be collected manually as the online system cannot accommodate this at the moment.</u>
