4. Bands may play one grade higher. If time permits.
5. Closing date for entries is Saturday 14th April
6. Draw will take place electronically on Tuesday 17th April and will be posted on the following websites: www.rspba.org and www.rspba-landb.org
7. Late entries may be accepted if time permits and bands will be asked to play first.
8. Any band requiring a coach pass must indicate on the online entry where applicable.
9. Bands may be asked to play for Drum Majors.
10. Bands are expected to take part in the March Past.
